PAINTING OF LINES ON TIMBER SPORTS FLOORS

Lines on timber sports floors can be completed successfully if applied strictly in accordance with the following recommendations:

- Prior to the application of the first coat of SOLVER Line 4838 Polysol Floor Gloss, sand the surface well and remove all sanding dust. A vacuum is of assistance for this process.
- Apply one coat of Floor Polysol and allow to dry overnight.
- Sand well and remove dust before continuing.
- Apply the required lines using SOLVER Line 4159 Brite Glo Enamel with SOLVER Line 4298 Dry Add at the recommended mixing ratio.
- If using masking tape to assist in the line marking process, carefully remove the masking tape immediately after the application of the paint, while still wet. This is necessary to avoid the capillary absorption of the paint under the tape which results in rough edges of the line.
- Allow the lines to dry for 72 hours. Sand lightly using 320 grade abrasive paper and remove all sanding dust and other surface contamination from the floor.

Apply a further three (3) coats of Floor Polysol with adequate drying times between coats as per recommendations on the Solver TP-4838-01 Product Information Sheet.
