What are VOCs?

Volatile Organic Compounds are carbon-based chemical substances that are found in most paints, stains and adhesives. They are released into the air when paint dries and may produce unpleasant odours as well as contribute to the loss of indoor air quality and to air pollution. Solver Maxi Enviroguard has less than 1g/litre of VOCs.
